What Do You Think?

1. Have you ever had to move for a job? What was that like?
2. If you were Abraham's wife, Sarah, what would have come out of your mouth the moment you arrived at this place that God was directing you to only to find out there is a famine in that place?
3. Sometimes Christians talk about how God 'opens doors' to things that are His will and 'closes doors' when they are not? Is Abraham showing up to a famine a closed door?
4. If we can't always rely on open or closed doors, Is there ever any way of discerning whether something is God's will or not?

So Now What?

1. Is there something in your life that you felt like God was leading you to but you gave up because you thought the door was closed?
2. Where do you need to reignite passion in your walk with God that you gave up on?
3. As a group, brainstorm some ways that you can help each other to re-ignite your passion for God. Whatever it is, talk about it and set up plans to do it.
